Zircon's new MetalliScanner M40 quickly and easily detects metal through concrete and most nonmetallic materials. Find plumbing, ductwork, rebar, nails and screws in your walls, floors and ceilings. Find studs in lath and plaster by locating the row of nails attaching the wood lath to the studs. The M40 works in two positions, a wide-scan mode, and by turning the nose of the scanner toward the work surface for pinpoint accuracy. Find ferrous (magnetic) metal such as rebar up to 4 inches deep. Find non-ferrous (non-magnetic) metal such as copper pipe up to 2 inches deep.

Circular Sander for Finishing Drywall

The new Radius360 sanding tool features a full 9-inch diameter, die-cast aluminum head with wide pivot brackets that give it a unique circular mobility. The EHT staff tested the tool and found that its round design practically eliminates flipping the sander on the wall surface, which can cause scratching and gouging. By eliminating the corners of a rectangular sander, the Radius360 can change directions on a dime, without having to lift the pad off the wall—a huge time-saver compared to the conventional drywall sanding method. The 1/2-inch-thick detachable foam disc also forms to the wall, providing a smooth, even finish, and unlike a conventional sand pole, the foam disc wears evenly, increasing the life of the tool. Both the foam pad and the Full Circle sandpaper use hook-and-loop backing for easy replacement.
